Founded MCFLS became one of the first four certified Wisconsin public library

systems in October, 1972 and began operation in 1973.

Area Served 1,189 square miles, all within Milwaukee County

Population Served 948,201 (2018 municipal/extended county population)

Demographics 27% of county residents are of African-American origin and 15% identify

as Hispanic, both of which are much higher than in the state as a whole. The median household income of \$45,263 is only 83% of the state-wide

level of \$54,610.

Libraries Served Service is provided to 28 public library locations within the service area

Governance MCFLS operates under Chapter 43 of the WISCONSIN STATUTES and is

governed by a 7-member Board of Trustees. The Milwaukee County

Executive appoints Trustees to the MCFLS Board.

Budget & Funding MCFLS' 2019 budget is \$4,375,532. Approximately 65% of our revenue

comes from the State of Wisconsin; 23% from member public libraries

and the remaining from service contracts, grants and interest.

access, technical expertise and support, online resources/databases, courier service, consultant service, continuing education and training for

library personnel and trustees.
