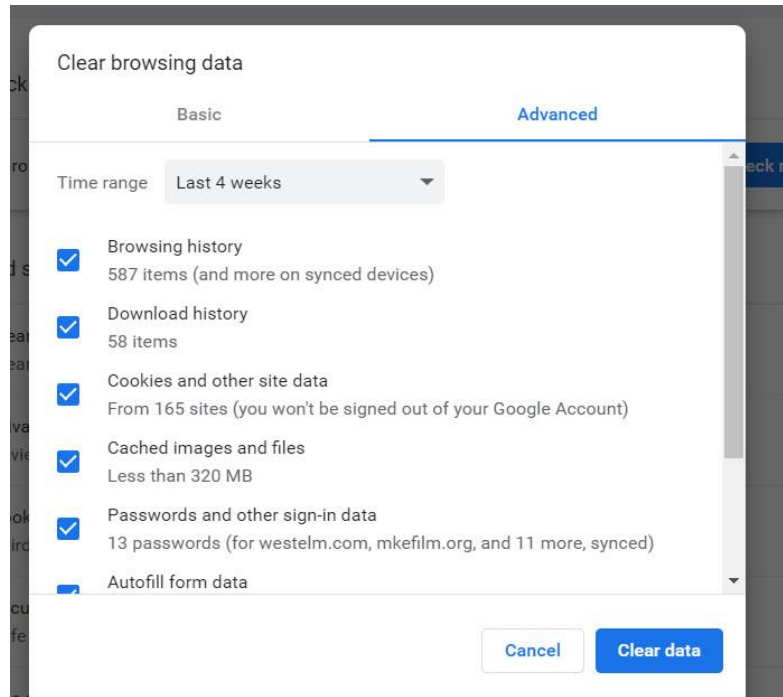


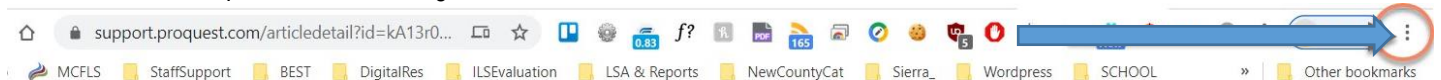
## HOW TO CLEAR THE WEB BROWSER DATA

If a person is having issues with a e-resource, sometimes it's best to clear the web browsing data to fix the problem. It can also help reformat data and reload information on a page. In theory, all web browsers should allow you to do this by pressing CTRL+SHIFT+DEL with the keyboard. Then follow the screen to clear data.



## CHROME - How to Clear the Browser Cache

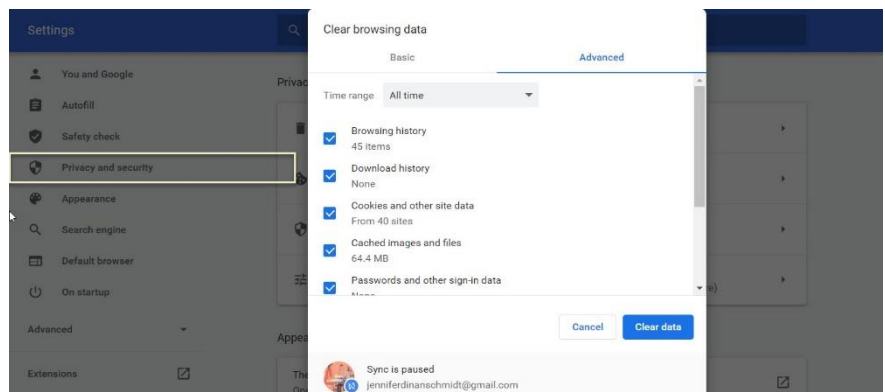
1. From the top menu bar to the right of the web address area, select the three dots.



2. From that point, choose SETTINGS.
3. Then on the left choose PRIVACY AND SECURITY.
4. In the middle of the screen, choose the arrow option to go into the area where you can Clear Browsing Data
5. Complete the task by choosing Clear Data, then return to the needed web page to perform your task.

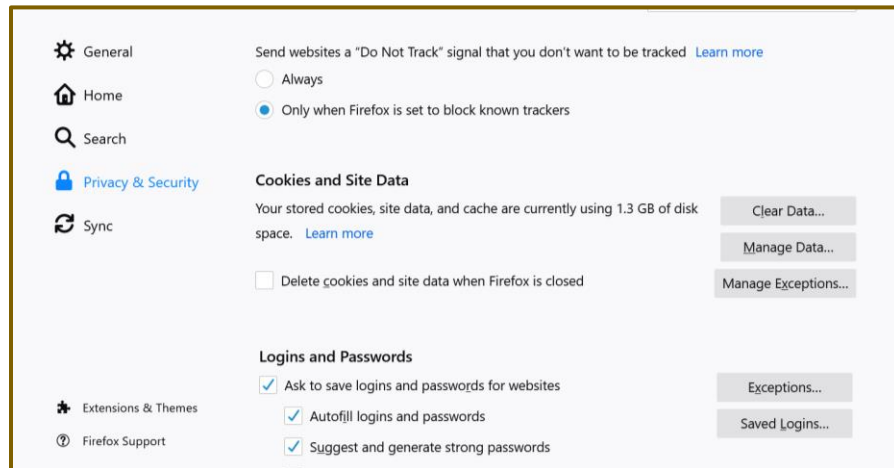
## FIREFOX – How To Clear Browsing Data/History

1. From the top menu bar to the right of the web address area, select the three horizontal lines.



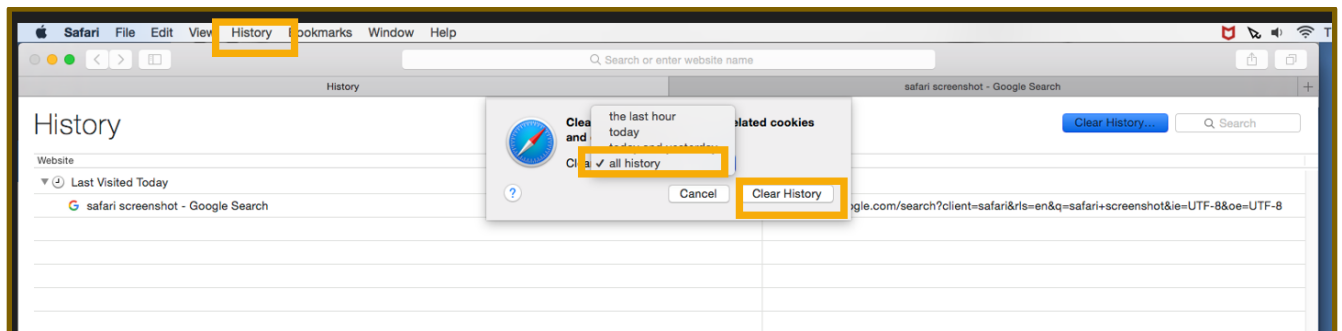


2. Click once and choose OPTIONS.
3. From the next screen choose PRIVACY & SECURITY.
4. Scroll down to the section called Cookies and Site Data. Click Clear Data and proceed with that action. Then close the tab or page and continue with your web tasks.






## SAFARI – How to Clear the Browsing History

1. From the top menu bar, select **History**
2. From the drop down menu, click Show All History
3. Click Clear History



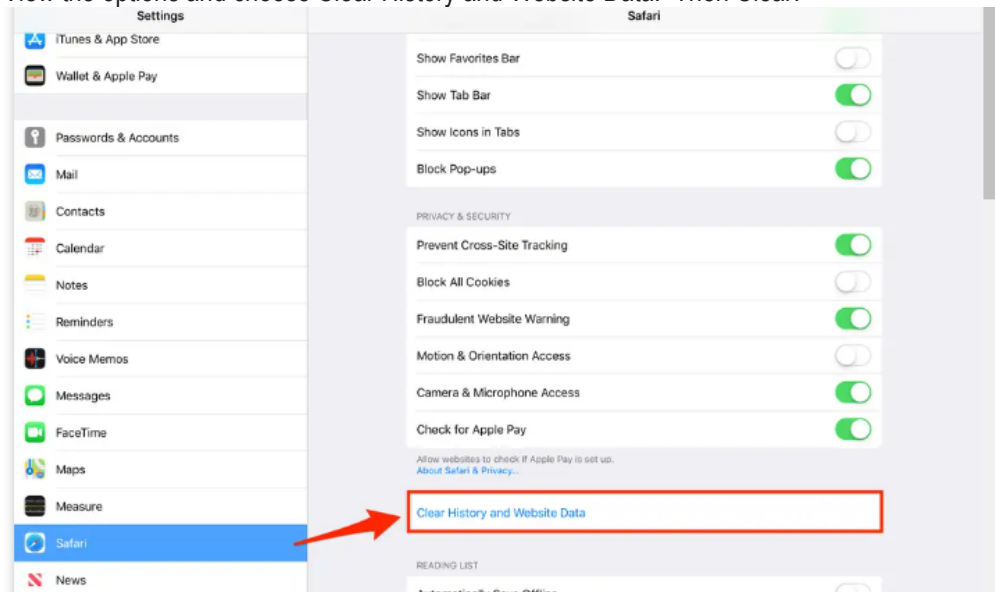
## IPAD – Clear the Browsing Data for the Chrome app

1. On your iPhone or iPad, find the Settings icon
2. Within Settings, locate and touch once to open the Chrome app .
3. At the top-right, tap More .
4. Tap History  scroll down and tap Clear browsing data.
5. Make sure that there's a tick mark next to 'Cookies, site data' and 'Cached images and files'.
6. Tap Clear browsing data.

## IPAD – Clear the browsing cache for Safari, the common iPad browser

1. Locate Settings on your iPad
2. Locate and touch to open the Safari browser
3. View the options and choose Clear History and Website Data. Then Clear.
