About the 1000 Books before Kindergarten Program

- This free program encourages you to read 1000 books with your child before they enter kindergarten to promote strong early literacy skills and bonding between caregiver and child.
- Download the free 1000 books app to your Apple or Android device (available in both Apple iTunes and Android's Google Play). Create an account in the app to start tracking books.
- If you do not wish to use the app, pick up a paper reading log from the library's information desk.
- Keep a list of the books you read with your child. In the app, you can track books by scanning the book's barcode or entering the title, author, or ISBN number of the book you want to record.
- If you read the same book more than once, record it again. Each reading counts for 1 book.
- Bring your device or paper log to the library information desk and show the librarian your reading achievements to receive your milestone awards: for every 100 books read you receive a sticker, and when you reach 500 books you receive a free book from the library.
- Once you have read 1000 books you will be receive a *Road to Reading* certificate, a 1000 books sticker, and your child's name will be placed on the library's 1000 Books bulletin board.
